Harold Josephson Award for Professional Promise in International Education

The **Harold Josephson Award** recognizes exemplary graduate students who demonstrate emerging leadership and are making significant contributions to the field of international education. This award was established to honor the memory of Dr. Josephson, a long-time leader of AIEA and Associate Vice Chancellor of International Programs at the University of North Carolina-Charlotte. The nominee's impact may be evidenced by their graduate study, involvement in international education initiatives, research related to international education, and/or other relevant contributions.

AIEA recognizes up to **two** Josephson awardees:

- The Student Professional Award, recognizing an advanced graduate student in any field who has already entered the professional ranks, and has distinguished him or herself as an emerging leader in international education
- 2. **The Student Award**, recognizing a graduate student at the master's or doctoral level across any discipline who has demonstrated exceptional promise in the field through research, campus activities, or other relevant contributions.

Honorees selected to receive this distinguished award in both categories will receive onstage recognition at the Awards Ceremony during our Annual Conference, a dedicated AIEA press release announcing their win, spotlight features on our website and social media channels, and complimentary Annual Conference registration (a \$500 value, student rate). In addition, the Student Award recipient will receive a \$1,000 travel grant to attend the Annual Conference.
