Definitions

Plans Secured includes those who indicated they were employed and those continuing education. **Employed** includes those who indicated they are working, in the military, and pursuing public service employment including full-time and part-time experiences.

Continuing Education includes graduate, veterinary, medical, and professional school and continuing education that is not graudate school.

Average Salary in based on full-time permanent employment. Salary only reported if n>4. **Internship Rate** includes a variety of experiential learning activities including, but not limited to, internships, field experiences, research/lab experiences, student teaching, and significant volunteer experiences.

Offer Rate is the percent of graduates who are actively seeking employment or education that secured plans or indicated at least one job offer.

Knowledge Rate is the percent of graduates for which CSU has reasonable and verifiable information regarding post-graduation plans.

Introduction

This report is intended to provide an overview of the first destination plans of those graduating from Colorado State University (CSU). Complete undergraduate results will be published on the Career Center website. Masters and PhD individual program results are not published and are intended for internal use only due to the unique nature and size of each graduate program.

Methodology:

All graduating students are encouraged to respond to the First Destination Survey as part of the Graduation Ready process. The current administration of the survey includes graduates from August 2022 through May 2023. Following best practices set by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE), follow-up data were gathered through multiple sources including the National Student Clearinghouse and LinkedIn. The overall knowledge rate (the percentage of graduates that CSU has knowledge of their post-graduation plans) was 76% (n=3,965) for undergraduate students and 69% (n=1,493) for graduate students. This survey does not require respondents to answer every question to be able to submit their responses; therefore, averages and percentages are calculated based on the total number of responses for each individual question.

Salient Undergraduate Student Findings:

- 90% of 2022-23 undergraduates had either a job offer or secured plans for employment/further education, and 87% had their plans secured by December 2023.
- Generally, undergraduates with racially-minoritized identities, Pell Grant recipients, first generation graduates, and students with disabilities¹ reported lower rates for plans secured. Trans, non-binary, and gender nonconforming undergraduate students also face greater challenges in the job search and have noticeably lower rates for employment than overall averages and their cisgendered peers.
- Internships continued to stand out as being correlated with higher rates of securing plans, higher average salaries, and higher rates of employment related to major/career plans. The internship rate for 2022-23 was 72%.
- CSU undergraduates reported being hired by over 1,700 unique employers. 84% of those unique employers hired a single CSU undergraduate, 9% hired two, and the remaining 7% hired three or more. Approximately 200 unique graduate schools admitted CSU students last year.
- The average salary (full-time permanent) reported by undergraduates was \$57,461. International and Multiracial graduates reported slightly lower average salaries and Asian respondent reported marginally higher average salaries. Students with disabilities¹, trans, non-binary, and gender nonconforming students, and cisgender women respondents reported notably lower salaries as compared to the CSU average. Pell Grant recipients and first generation graduates reported salaries on par with the CSU average.
- 81% of undergraduates employed indicated their employment was related to their major and 87% indicated their employment was related to their career plans. Asian, Hispanic/Latino, first generation graduates, Pell Grant recipients, and trans, non-binary, and gender nonconforming students reported slightly lower rates of employment related to their career plans and their major. Students with disabilities¹ reported marginally higher rates of employment related to their major and career plans.
- 73% of employed undergraduates secured plans in Colorado; students found employment in 47 states and the District of Columbia. Of those that found employment in Colorado, 40% did so in the Denver Metro area and 50% did so in the Northern Colorado area.

Salient Graduate Student Findings:

- 97% of graduate students reported at least one job offer or secured plans for employment/further education, and 97% had secured their plans secured by December 2023.
- Cisgender women, trans, non-binary and gender nonconforming students, international students, and students with disabilities¹ reported lower rates of plans secured than the CSU population. Black, Hispanic/Latino, and Native American students reported higher rates of plans secured than the CSU average.
- Approximately 680 unique employers hired CSU graduate students, with 90% of employers hiring one graduate, 6% hiring two graduates, and the remaining 4% hiring three or more graduate students.
- 89% of students indicated that their employment was related to their graduate program, while 88% indicated their employment was related to their career plans. Generally, Black and trans, non-binary and gender non-confirming respondents reported lower rates for both, and international students reported higher rates. Students with disabilities¹ reported noticeably higher rates of employment related to their career plans and graduate program.
- 52% of employed graduate students secured employment in Colorado; graduate students found employment in 48 states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico. Of those that found employment in Colorado, 36% did so in the Denver Metro area and 48% did so in the Northern Colorado area.
