Planning for college can begin as early as Kindergarten! Through College Awareness Month, the CollegeBound Foundation, Baltimore City Public Schools and their partners help parents and teachers begin the process of raising college awareness among Baltimore's future achievers.

This free art, essay and poetry/spoken word contest is for Baltimore City Public School students in Kindergarten through 8th grade. The contest produces 27 winners (1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each grade group -- K-2, 3-5, 6-8 -- in each category of Art, Essay, and Poetry.)

Entry Requirements

Electronic entries are strongly encouraged via QR code or CollegeBound website.

Entries must be no smaller than 8½" x 11" paper, and no larger than 18" x 24". The unlined paper must be white or off-white, paper. Any art media, such as crayons, markers, watercolors, tempera or pastels, may be used to create the art design. Words must be hand-written.

*Art entries must be flat; (three-dimensional entries will <u>not</u> be accepted).

ESSAY

8½" x 11" paper, not to exceed 250 words. Typed and hand-written entries are accepted.

POETRY/SPOKEN WORD

8½" x 11" paper, not to exceed 100 words. Typed and hand-written entries are accepted.
